## Special Exception for the TOEFL-iBT, the English Language Proficiency Requirements

If the TOEFL-iBT is canceled due to the impact of COVID-19 infection, and applicants are unable to submit the score report during the application period, the TOEFL-iBT Home Edition score report will be accepted as Special Exception only if applicants can prove that TOEFL-iBT cancellation. The details of this special exception are below.

### 1. Submission of the proof documents

Please submit proof documents by e-mail in advance the TOEFL-iBT has been canceled affected by the impact of COVID-19 and that you will be unable to submit the score report during the application period. The submitted documents will be reviewed by the Student Affairs Division of Design, Kyushu University to determine whether or not they are eligible for the special exception.
