## Exemption from Application Fee

① Application Requirements

Those who fall under the following categories are eligible to apply for the exemption from the application fee.

- A Applicants who were affected by the Great East Japan Earthquake, the Kumamoto Earthquakes, the torrential rain in July 2018, the Hokkaido Eastern Iburi earthquake, Typhoon No. 19 in 2019, the torrential rain in July 2020, and the Noto Peninsula Earthquake in 2024, who were in an area covered by the Disaster Relief Law, and who fall under any of the following
  - (a) Applicants whose main financial supporter's house has been completely or partially destroyed or washed away
  - (b) If the main financial supporter has passed away or missing
  - \*\*For applicants who were affected by the disaster in areas other than covered by the Disaster Relief Act, and who fall under either (a) or (b) above, please consult with the Student Affairs Section, Graduate School of Design.
- B Those whose place of residence was designated as an evacuation-directed area (including a planned evacuation zone) due to the Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Plant accident caused by the Great East Japan Earthquake

The following documents are required for the application.

- ・Application Form 「入学検定料免除申請書」(Download from the website of the Kyushu University, Japanese Only)
- In case you fall under ①A@: a disaster victim certificate(Risai Shomeisho)
- In case you fall under ①AD: a death certificate or a document proving the person is missing
- In case you fall under ①B: a disaster affected certificate(Hisai Shomeisho)
